#### Types of conferences

Big, small, symposia, seminars, workshops etc.

Organizing committee, advisory committee, honorary committee etc.

Invited or keynote speakers

#### Types of sessions

Plenary, parallel, working groups Session chairmen, conveners

### Types of presentations

Invited talks, contributed talks, communications, posters Blackboard talks, slides, computer presentations Questions and comments Panel discussions

### **Conference proceedings**

Journals which publish conference proceedings Is it needed?

#### Who pays for a conference?

Sponsors, conference fees, fellowships, funding of invited speakers

### **Predatory conferences**

Luxury resorts and expensive hotels
