The theme panels of the conference cover four areas of interest, namely culture, literature, linguistics and glottodidactics. We kindly invite scholars to participate in the conference and make contributions to discussions on the following topics:

The subject of the debate within the <u>cultural panel</u> will be broadly understood modern English-language culture. The cultural trends and phenomena under discussion will include: cultural normativity vs. cultural contestation in the form of subcultures and counterculture, ethnic diversity vs. cultural homogenization in the age of globalization, cyberculture and social media and their role in shaping culture-forming processes. Analyses and interpretations are expected to be interdisciplinary – expressions of culture in film, literature and the media are going to be discussed.

The <u>literature panel</u> of the conference will focus on textual, intertextual and comparative encounters within British,

Commonwealth and American literatures as well as between British and American authors; mainstream and ethnic writing (African American, Native American, Hispanic, Chicano, etc.); regional literatures of the American North and South; East and West; past and present; traditionalism and modernity; history and collective memory; theory and practice; form and content; literature and its film adaptations; biography and autobiography; utopia and dystopia; fiction and metafiction.

Linguistic workshop: We would like to invite researchers to present papers which scope over linguistics and other disciplines of humanities. In particular, we expect papers dealing with applied linguistics (application of linguistic research in foreign language teaching, creation and use of language corpora, contrastive studies serving the purpose of teaching a foreign language). Similarly, we invite researches to present papers which incorporate linguistic and cultural studies (linguistic characteristics of specific groups of speakers, dialects, jargons, etc.). Finally, we expect papers concerning the varieties of language characterizing specific examples of belles- lettres (including comics and literature created on-line), artistic devices or particular writers. The conference does not limit the theoretical bias of particular papers: we invite generativists, cognitivists and others.

The theme of the conference <u>panel devoted to glottodidactics</u> will concern, among other topics, preservice teacher education at (pre) primary level. We will contribute to an ongoing discussion how to improve prospective teachers' professional competences by sharing

research findings and good practices covering all the important phases of forming the competences. The topics will include: subjectrelated training, training in psychology, methodological training as well as practicum.
